After your account is created, it confirms your information with you and gives you the link you'll use to sign into Unified Classroom. It also gives you a button to click on to return to the unified classroom sign in page. Click this button and then sign in with your new account.

Once you sign in, you'll get a screen where you can begin to link your students. If you have never had an account, you'll need the student access ID and access password. You can get these from the school, either by stopping in, or having them send it home with your child. Schools cannot email this information, or give it over the phone. When you have it, click the button labelled I have a Student Access Code.

If you previously had your own account created, you can click the second button, I have a Username and Password in my district's PowerSchool Parent Portal, and use that to add your students.
