DO YOU HAVE A RESUME??

Now is a great time to build your resume! A resume is a detailed list of all the jobs you've had, the positions you've held, and includes all of your job responsibilities. A resume also includes all of your contact information, reference names and phone numbers, educational background, and your mission statement (your career goals). Once you've completed your resume, you can simply add to it with every new job you obtain. Just think, you go into a business and ask if they're hiring, they give you an application to fill out and you include a detailed resume with the application! It's so simple, yet so professional! Some of the scholarship applications ask to see a resume as well!
