

Student on Student Harassment

It is the policy of MSAD 52 to provide a learning environment which is free of harassment. In order to establish such an environment, the following types of student behavior are prohibited:

- A. Spoken or written ridicule, bullying, slurs, derogatory actions or remarks;
- B. Threats, including, but not limited to, spoken, written, electronic or physical threats;
- C. Offensive jokes;
- D. Unwelcome sexual advances, gestures, comments, or contact; and
- E. Reprisals or retaliations towards an individual who makes a good faith report of harassment.

All students will be given training annually by district guidance counselors and/or other school personnel on the definition, appropriate response, and consequences of such harassment. Any incident of student harassment will be reported to the building administrator for investigation and action. Parents/guardians of any student exhibiting such behavior will be contacted. If such harassment by an individual is repeated, it will be reported to the MSAD 52 District Affirmative Action Coordinator for investigation and recommendation of appropriate action.
