

EXTRA/CO-CURRICULAR ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY PROCEDURES
TRIPP MIDDLE SCHOOL

- Before the start of the student day following September 30th. Thereafter, eligibility will be reviewed before the start of the student day following the 15th of every month.
- Tier one: Students maintaining course grades of 2.6 or above based on the overall grade in all classes will immediately be considered eligible for the current grading period.
- Tier two: If the student has a course grade(s) below 2.6, but not less than 2.0, the Habits of Work (H.O.W.) score(s) from those courses will be considered. If the H.O.W. score in the course is 2.6 or above, the student will be considered eligible. If the H.O.W. in the course is below a 2.6, the student would be ineligible.
- Tier three: If a student has a course grade below a 2.0, that student will not be eligible to participate in an extra curricular activity until the above expectations are met.
- If a student does not improve the grade within a two-week window, the student will be ineligible for the team/extra-curricular activity for the season/trimester.
- If a student becomes ineligible in a year-long activity, they may rejoin that activity at the beginning of the next trimester if they have passing grades.
- Any ineligible student will receive a letter that will be signed and returned by the parent.
- If a student is absent when the homework is assigned or collected, teachers will not enter a zero for the assignment.
