

EXTRA/CO-CURRICULAR ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY PROCEDURES
TRIPP MIDDLE SCHOOL

- Before the start of the student day following the 15th and 30th, grades will be reviewed.
- If the student has earned less than a 2.6 in any subject, or less than 2.0 on any single standard, they are ineligible. Grades will be checked for those ineligible students five school days later in the morning. If they are in compliance at that time, they go back to their team. If not, they continue to be ineligible. If any ineligible student is not eligible after two weeks, he/she is off the team.
- If the student who returned to the team after one week is not eligible at the next grade check, he/she will be off the team.
- If a student becomes ineligible in a year-long activity, they may rejoin that activity at the beginning of the next trimester if they have passing grades.
- Any ineligible student will receive a letter that will be signed and returned by the parent.
- If a student is absent when the homework is assigned or collected, teachers will not enter a zero for the assignment.
