

### Use of School Facilities

The Board of Directors of M.S.A.D. #52 recognizes that the district's school facilities belong to its citizens and will make every effort to make the facilities available as much as possible to responsible organizations, associations and individuals of the community for appropriate use. Such use will be subject to related regulations and exhibits adopted by the Board.

The use of school facilities for school educational activities, sanctioned extra-curricular activities, and activities of any organization which exists solely for the purpose of supporting school programs will in that order at all times take precedence over any community use of those facilities.

The hours during which school facilities are used, will, to the extent possible, coincide with the hours during which custodians are regularly scheduled.

Groups using school facilities for MSAD #52 educational purposes or Board-sanctioned, extra-curricular activities will not pay for regularly scheduled custodial services or other fees. Other groups and organizations may be required to pay a rental fee and will be required to pay for custodial services, if services are required above and beyond normal custodial schedules.

School facilities will not be available for the use of those organizations and activities that seek to:

- A. Promulgate any theory or doctrine subversive to the laws of the United States or any of its political sub-divisions.
- B. Advocate governmental change by violence.
- C. Violate the canons of acceptable community morals, manners, or taste, or be injurious to buildings, grounds, or equipment.
- D. Interfere or conflict with the best interest or conduct of school activities.
- E. Promote activities that are discriminatory.
